Reservation Facts

Bathroom Facilities:

- For campsites there will be port-a-johns on located on the field near the campsites along with a designated building (which will be a distance from the site).
- For RV's (same as above)
- For rooms bathrooms are located in each building (no rooms have individual bathrooms) SEE MAP OF EAST & WEST WING

Shower Facilities:

- For campsites a designated building will be assigned
- For RV's (same as above)
- For rooms there are showers located in each building (no rooms have individual showers) SEE MAP OF EAST & WEST WING

***Keep in mind this is a children's camp and the bathroom/shower facilities are designed for a camp setting. Rooms have a bed and dresser ONLY. Rooms are on a first come, first serve basis.

Rowboats for fishing ONLY

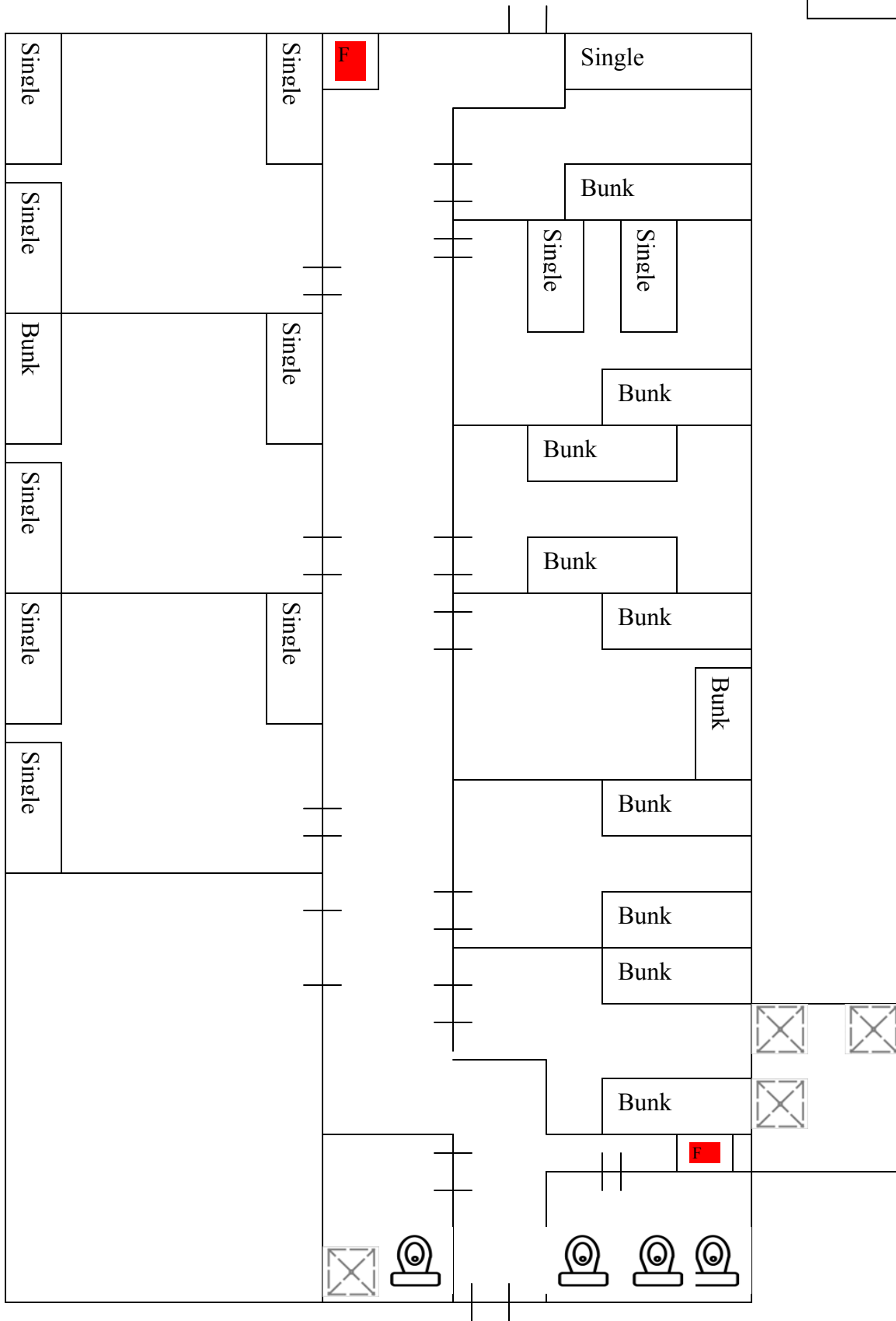
Fishing

Over 16 must have valid NYS lic.
From shore dusk until dawn
From row boats during waterfront hours only (can't bring own boat)
Bring own fishing gear
Lifejackets must be WORN!
No bait fish – worms, grubs, etc. or lures
No fishing in swimming area

General

No open camp fires
Quiet hours 11 pm to 7 am
Children under 14 must be supervised at all times
RV's must be self contained
NO Smoking allowed
NO Alcohol allowed
NO Pets allowed
MAX. 2 tents to site
